Know all Men by these Presents that
 we Christian Rabenhorst, Clerk & Anna Barbara, daughter
 of the late M^r Brauts relict of the deceased M^r David Wapf,
 & now the lawful wife of the aforesaid Christian Rabenhorst
 both of Ebingen in His Britannick Majesty's Province
 Georgia inhabitants, are jointly & severally holden &
 firmly bound unto the Reverend M^r Frederick
 Liegenhagen, His Majesty's Chaplain at St
 James, in London, the Rev^d M^r August Urbsperger
 President of the Rev^d Ministry in Augsburg
 and the Rev^d M^r Anastasius Freylinghausen,
 Director in Halle for the time being, worthy
 member of the Venerable Society in London for Promoting
 Christian Knowledge, in the Penal sum of One Thousand
 two hundred, and ninety nine Pounds, twelve shillings
 and ten pence sterling money, to be paid, or caused to be
 paid, unto the said Reverend Messrs Frederick
 Liegenhagen, August Urbsperger,
 and Anastasius Freylinghausen to their certain
 attornies or assigns, for the true payment whereof, We bind and obliger ourselves,
 our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents, sealed with our
 seals dated this second day of January in the fifteenth year of the reign of our
 Sovereign King George the third, Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
 and seventy five.

Memorand: Be it known unto all whom it may concern: Whereas
 the Reverend Gentlemen Messrs. Samuel M^r Wapferger, Godtfrid August Franke
 of late and the survivors, Frederick Liegenhagen, August Urbsperger, and
 Anastasius Freylinghausen did before some years, collect and gather
 charitable gifts and mites by subscriptions among Protestant Christians in
 Europe, amounting to the sum of six hundred and forty nine pounds sixteen
 shillings and five pence and did devise and bequeath the said sum for a
 lasting fund, and the interest thereon towards a yearly support for a
 third regular protestant Minister, professing the Protestant Lutheran

Doctrine according to the Augustan Confession and Liturgy in and about Ebenzer in Georgia, and whereas the above named S. T. Rev. Founders and Directors did intrust the Revd. Mr. Christian Rabenhorst with the said Sum designed and appointed for the said fund, and did assign the interest thereof unto him the said Minister Rabenhorst, During his good behaviour and life, or until he should succeed his Antecessors and become first Minister of the Ebenzer congregation and be provided from the Venerable Society in London for promoting Christian Knowledge and from the revenues of charitable Work appertaining to the said Protestant congregation in and about Ebenzer.

The condition of the above obligation is therefore such, that if the above bounden Revd. Mr. Christian Rabenhorst, and Mistr Anna Barbara Rabenhorst, their Heirs Executors, administrators or either of them, Do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named Revd. Gentlemen Trustees and Directors, of the said institution viz. Messrs. Frederick Siegenhagen, August Ursperger, and Anastasius Freislinghausen, their certain Attornies or assigns, the just and full Sum of six hundred and forty nine pounds sixteen shillings and five pence sterling of good and lawful money of Great Britain either immediately after his being declared first Minister of the Ebenzer congregation and provided with a sufficient salary from the Venerable Society, and the Revd. Trustees and directors aforesaid, or immediately after the decease of the said Mr. Rabenhorst if it should please the Lord to call his soul out of this troublesome world unto everlasting rest and glory then this obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to stand and remain in full force and virtue.
