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consistency in my character I should certainly ~~also look~~ for nothing
else than for doing every moment what I ought to do and
never trouble myself about future time. In this very
moment I desire to be so, I will now kneel down, I will
~~ask~~ pray to my Lord, to disengage my mind from thinking
always of my appointment, to accelerate it if possible
but to lead my mind only to what is agreeable to him.
I will join also a prayer to bless ~~the~~ ^{to} night the
conversation of my students and to teach me humility
and wisdom to choose in every respect the best means
of awakening them.

Ponnabund 7 Dec. 22. On the whole I have had a season of steadiness and
faithfulness. I committed every thing to God and my joy consisted
only in the entire reliance in God, I am his servant, I wish ever
to be his servant and this suffices. Last night I was with
~~Frederick~~ at Oros. The wavering state of Dr. caused me much
grief. In the morning I had been at Sem. Weber's, ~~and~~ from
there I went to Ludi, where I took a cup of chocolate. I
