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5 July 27 Wednesday Ab. 11. I am just returned from Hodge, we talked at last of Novatis & he said: Now consider what an enjoyment it will be in another world to know the history of the human heart. - Yesterday Wile & Krumpholtz have been here, they & Baum & Gies. took coffee in the garden, we talked about the evening. Kirchens. I was much encouraged. - Today afternoon dear dear little Kr. was here, I like him most of all I think, he is so very straightforward, he spoke to me about his inability to assure infidels of his God happiness in Christ. In the mean time Reincke entered, declaring that he was very unhappy & that a cold resignation was all that remained to him. There we celebrated a triumph of faith. - O that God may raise to himself a chosen people in this place. Hodge living here is certainly a gracious providence of God, to find so unexpectedly a friend who is so attached to me - I had been vexed in the course of last week of Paulin ^{Heidelberg} En tr ism I wrote to de Lay & Koregart, the same day I wrote to Wernicke to repair my fault - I have weighed the idea, that every teleological idea of ours is true, it is one side of the plan of harmony of God.
