letter of the Minister respecting Lücke which I sent to Twerten, &
most gratified at the notice given by Peths that of Hebrew there
are 112 copies, John 120, Lunde 88, Glanbeu. 100. It grieved me greatly
that the Hebrew did not seem to sell very promptly, for in Nov Peths
wrote that 270 copies were unsold. I see that I have much to alter
