15. Juli, 22. August 1839

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15 July 39 Wednesday evening. At 11 o'clock walked with
Baseman who obtained Mr. Wunderlich, Lane fr. Glitz ran,
 at 5 with Gerlach fr. Lühl, Lahme fr. Böcher & a Mr Hare
 from Weimar. Allice dangerously ill, all the days troubled
concerning the house. It is really painful to see that if
 we had kept Krue, we should have saved so much money.
Carlsberg Wahr fr. Armswink & Wink fr. Salberg was
 here & all mine. The money fr. Wink & Salberg. I often think
 from much should have been saved without the danger
 however then it should have been spent in other ways.

22 Aug 39 Promenade at 11 with Gerlach Lahme, Schumacher
 related of Genies reports, at 5 with Smith & Prince,
 evening Pruss Holz. Wink fr. Settin & Gerlach from Lühl

18 Sept. 39 Arrived the 26th, evening to the water
 in the first person Mr Smithwick, then Mr Schütz, next
 morning Capt Bell & understood to my great annoyance
 that Dräcker & Benson had been here. I walk with
Smithw. to the Podentumbe & the following day with
Bell to the Salinen, one day with Green, revisited
 the Templemountain with Reckedrons, till Friday
 yet grumbling, but since Sunday a new era, a
 blessed excursion to Schw., intended to speak to
T. about it, but he turned away from the subject
 so all was well & since that day indeed all
 altered, all on the advance. So happy that
 no grumbling at the weather, last evening with
Frédéric Trench & Capt Bell a while, this morning
Mr Gordart introduced himself to me, the evening
 before pleasing talk with Smithwick & Monday
