In the Romans I had been anticipating few there were 139, in the Synopsis many there came but 65. Confide on him teacher on heart! From the comm. on the Hebrew I anticipated honour & have been covered with shame, from the new ed. from the Romans I anticipate shame & may earn honour.

Sunday 30 Jan 42. All the days before in Synopsis not many more but twenty & also in Moral they dropped fast and more than perhaps 100-110 will not be present. The more I was surprised & thankful for the serenade on Friday, & the 7 that combined with it, though from the consequences how lamentable the state of things is actually I was not very gladly moved. There is scarcely an instance of my walking with a new one. However Freisleben from Cöthen was introduced who seemed a promising youth not so dull as the Cöthen people are.
