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24) If use determines the apprehension of our outward senses, it is no wonder the depravation of our inward senses strengthened by custom should betray us into so many errors. What we see in a looking glass seems to be so far behind the looking glass, as it is before it, because our eye is used to see allways in a straight line forward, so likewise our mind judges rather by custom than by reality.

A great many fancy they know Christ, and nevertheless are so far from having eternal life, that they are neither in the hopes of nor in the way to it. Some call knowing of a man, when they have seen his body, without considering that the soul is the main part of the man. Those that have an experimental knowledge of that light and truth, which Christ imparted unto the soul, may be said to know him, herein consists that real life, which was denied unto man, when he was created אלהים. when David reflected upon it, he found that our life was but a death and a pit without it; and his soul was struck with terror and anguish when he wanted it.
