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Halle March the 17.th 1698.

I heartily thank you once more for all the love you have shewed me during my stay with you. God almighty grant a merciful blessing to our transactions, and establish us more and more in Christ Jesus our Master, to joyn hearts and capacities for the carrying on of the interest of the whole body, whereof our saviour is the head. I hope Mr. Turner delivered unto you Mr. Sargents packet, which may have informed you of my having delivered unto him your letter. I found him very courteous to me, and possess'd with very good notions against the obstructers of piety and real Christianity; I shall think it a happiness if upon my occasion you come to a good understanding and intimacy with him, for he may be very usefull to us. Mr. Frenzel hath entertained me very kindly during my stay at Leipzig, which place I left on munday in the afternoon, but the wayes were so bad, that we did not arrive at Weissenfels till tuesday morning; we stuck in several places, and within an hour of Weissenfels, we could get neither forward nor back, waded and were forced to send for more horses to Weissenfels. I received at Leipzig Mr. Elers letter, with the inclose from Mr. Merlman; I heartily thank him for it and for all the kind expressions contained in it, his zeal for being serviceable in the work of the Lord will allwayes endear his memory to me. I send you here inclosed an open letter to Mr. Dorrington which I beseech you to seal up after you have perused it, and convey it forward to Amsterdam as soon as you write to Mr. Neubauer. I suppose I need not recommend unto ^{you} the improving of Mr. Dorringtons correspondence with all possible carefulness. The packet ~~contains~~ contains the book Mr. Dorrington desired, in my letter ~~you will see what I write about it.~~ If you see Mr. Rauner, pray present my services to him and tell him that I took care of his letters. My services likewise to your Lady, Mr. Elers and Mr. Turner, I shall write to him when I come to Erford, in the mean while I would have him keep himself in readiness to leave Halle at the latter end of this month.
